Their slow tempi and harmonic rhythm render them suited for a large acoustic. From needing danger, Through thy submitting all and Heare us, O heare us Lord.



BYRD, William Mass for five voices Vocal score Chester edition

Written around 1590, this masterpiece of English choral music is an unaccompanied mass setting for SATTB voices, now available in the preferred 1960 edition by Henry Washington, in the key of C minor, around 22'.

Arranged here for mixed choir and piano by David Brunner, Irving Fine, Glenn Koponen, Gregory Rose, and R. Wilding-White collected for the first time in a complete edition. Includes the original notes on the songs, such as Simple Gifts and Ching-a-ring Chaw



MONTEVERDI, Claudio Messa à quattro voci da cappella Choral score Carus-verlag edition

5 movements (Kyrie, Gloria, Credo, Sanctus & Benedictus, Agnus Dei) in a definitive Urtext edition by Rudolf Walter. Composed sometime after 1610 for SATB voices, and published posthumously in 1650 by Alessandro Vincenti, with an ad lib organ part (separate copy). Around 25'

Vocal score Ben Palmer edition Commissioned by Woking Choral Society in 2015, arranged here for mixed SATB choir and chamber ensemble 1.1.1.1-hp-str(min1.1.1.1). Duration 12', in 5 linked movements with some words by William Cornysh.
